## Fire Safety: How You Can Play An Important Role

*Fire Prevention Keeps Your Home Safe*

Fire safety is a top priority of CRC Self-Help, and we need your help in keeping our homes safe for everyone.

Smoke detectors and alarms are a crucial component of fire detection and prevention, so we ask that you refrain from tampering or removing any smoke detectors or the batteries inside the detectors/alarms.

Also for units that have fire doors, please do not put wedges in the doors to prop them open. This causes damage to the door and door frame, and is a violation with Toronto Fire Services.

Also a reminder that no smoking is allowed in the common areas of the houses. Thank you for your help!



## Pest Control

As the weather is changing, various pests will look for warmer places, so it is important that you keep your rooms and the common areas clear of clutter, garbage, empty cardboard boxes, etc.

CRC Self-Help needs your help in keeping your units and houses clean, to prevent pests from entering your space.

A reminder to take out all trash to the garbage bins collected by the City of Toronto, and not leave trash to collect in the kitchen or common areas.

Together we can keep the houses clean and keep on top of pest control!

## Locking Doors and Lost Keys

*Locking doors keeps your home safe*

There have been reports of some doors at CRC Self-Help homes being left unlocked. To provide safety to the home and your fellow housemates, it's vital that all doors are locked, to prevent unwanted entry by people that do not live in the home.

If you lose your key, please call the office at (416) 591-6389, to arrange to get a replacement key.

There is a fee to obtaining a replacement key(s), but if you are unable to pay at the time you lose your key(s), CRC Self-Help will still issue a key to you, and work out payment arrangements. Keeping doors locked insures your property and the property of your housemates and CRC Self-Help are kept safe.
